

## **SUMMARY OF RULE CHANGES**

APPROVED AT THE STATE BOARD MEETING 04/08/2014

1. Rule 14. Requires Branches serving Liquor to have two bartenders certified by a responsible beverage server certification program. Documentation required is the certificates of completion. Branches could lose their liquor liability insurance if they fail to comply with this rule.
  
2. Rule 28. This Rule, created in January of 2014 was deemed unnecessary, and was deleted in its entirety.
  
3. Rule 224. New rule requires reporting of monthly income from the sale of alcohol on a separate line on Branch Form 28. Total annual receipts for the sale of alcohol are to be reported to the Chairman of the State Insurance Committee.
  
4. Rule 810. Revised to specify the procedure for calling a special meeting of the State Board of Directors not called by the President.
