## Proposed Bylaw Revisions for 8/25/22 Annual Meeting

# (The following Bylaws are approved by the State Board for action at the Annual Meeting. Additions/revisions in bold with strikethroughs) 

## Bylaws 130, 131, 140, 141.

Background: The Assistant State Secretary and Assistant State Treasurer positions typically have not been used by incumbents to become State Secretary or State Treasurer, nor are they expected to in the future. Therefore, these positions are proposed for elimination from the State Board after 2022.

## Proposals:

Bylaw 130. Members of the Corporation shall consist of the President, Vice President, Chief Administrative Officer, State Secretary, State Treasurer, Assistant State Secretary, Assistant State Treasuref, Regional Directors, Area Governors, Big Sirs of the Chartered Branches and Past Presidents. (Revised 8/7/06 effective 1/1/07) (Revised 8/1/16 effective 1/1/17) (Revised 8/25/22)

Bylaw 131. All Members of the Corporation shall be entitled to vote at the Annual Meeting in the election of the President, Vice President, Chief Administrative Officer, State Secretary, and State Treasurer, Assistant State Secretary and Assistant State Treasurer, and on amendments to the Corporate and Branch Bylaws. (Revised 8/7/06 effective 1/1/07),(8/1/16 effective 1/1/17) (Revised 8/25/22)

Bylaw 140. The Officers of the Corporation are the President, Vice President, Chief Administrative Officer, State Secretary, State Treasurer, Assistant State Secretary, Assistant State-Treasuref, Regional Directors and Area Governors. (Revised 8/7/06 effective $1 / 1 / 07$ )( $8 / 1 / 16$ effective $1 / 1 / 17$ ) (Revised 8/25/22)

Bylaw 141. The President, Vice President, Chief Administrative Officer, State Secretary, State Treasurer,Assistant State Secretary, Assistant State Treasurer, and all Regional Directors as specified in the Policies and Procedures, shall constitute the State Board and shall have voting rights on all matters before the Board. (Revised 8/7/06 effective 1/1/07)(8/1/16 effective 1/1/17) (8/8/17) (Revised 8/25/22)

## Bylaw 148.

Background: There has been no term limit for regularly elected State Officers (Officers of the Corporation) in the Bylaws. This proposal restricts State Officers to three consecutive terms, which can be waived by the State Board.

## Proposal:

Bylaw 148. Except as otherwise provided herein, a regularly elected Officer of the Corporation shall serve for one calendar year and be restricted to three consecutive terms (excluding any partial year immediately preceding the first such year) and
until his successor is elected and installed. If an officer is appointed or elected after a calendar year commences to any office for the remainder of such year, such year shall not be counted in applying any term limit. The State Board may waive term limits. (Revised 8/4/03) (Revised 8/25/22)

## Bylaw 151.

Background: Presiding over the the filling of a Regional Director vacancy by the Vice President is considered preferable to the "Area Governor of the lowest numbered Area in the Region". Filling this vacancy is a high-priority issue that can be more efficient and effective with this change.

## Proposal:

Bylaw 151. A vacancy in the office of Regional Director shall be filled by a majority vote by the Area Governors of the Region at a meeting called and presided over by the Vice President. Area Governor of the lowest numbered Area in the Region. A vacancy in the office of Regional Director shall be filled as soon as possible.
(Revised 8/25/22)

## Bylaw 154.

Background: Presiding over the the filling of an Area Governor vacancy by the Regional Director is considered preferable to the "Big Sir of the lowest numbered Branch of the Area." Filling this vacancy is a high-priority issue that can be more efficient and effective with this change.

## Proposal:

Bylaw 154. A vacancy in the office of Area Governor shall be filled by a majority vote of the Big Little Sirs of the Area at a meeting called and presided over by the Regional Director Big Sir of the lowest numbered Branch of the Area. A vacancy in the office of Area Governor shall be filled as soon as possible.
