PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

Submitted Previously to the President for Consideration and Herein Submitted to the State Board for Approval

Rules changes were approved by the State Rules Committee by email on or about 4/15/10 and 5/15/10 Tom Smith, Chairman

Note: Deleted text is strikeout, new text is **bold**, and comments are in *italics*.

Area Governor Duties

Rule 896 requires the appointment of an Area Travel Coordinator along with other activity chairs. A change will support the Governor's power to approve or not approve other positions that would help his area and will provide a more flexible format to the rule.

The existing rule -

RULE 896. In addition to appointing an Area Travel Coordinator, the Area Governor shall appoint chairmen of the Area Golf, Bowling and such Area other activities as may be required.

The proposed revised rule -

RULE 896. In addition to appointing an Area Travel Coordinator, The Area Governor shall may appoint chairmen of the Area Golf, Bowling and such Area other activities as may be required. an Area Chairman for any activity such as Travel, Speakers Exchange, Golf, Bowling, etc, as may be deemed appropriate to facilitate the conduct of SIR activities beyond the Branch level. (Revised xx/xx/xx)

The proposed final wording -

RULE 896. The Area Governor may appoint an Area Chairman for any activity such as Travel, Speakers Exchange, Golf, Bowling, etc, as may be deemed appropriate to facilitate the conduct of SIR activities beyond the Branch level. (Revised xx/xx/xx)

Duties of President

The only reference in the SIR Manual to the timeliness of the annual Presidential appointments to State Committees etc is in Rule 766.

The existing rule -

RULE 766. Annually, before the commencement of his term of office as President, the Presidentelect shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of: (a) a chairman who shall be the then current President or; if unable to serve, the most recent Past President available; (b) one other Past President; and (c) three other members other than Past Presidents, who shall be past or present Regional Directors or Area Governors. (Revised 1/28/03 by the Excom) (Confirmed 4/15/03)

Rule 766 implies the President has until December 31 to make his appointments, which is too late for reflecting the appointments in the State Roster for the ensuing year that is published in early October. And the fact that there is no reference to all of the other necessary appointments, we need to be somewhat specific pertaining to the timing, as follows -

The proposed revised rule -

RULE 766. Annually, before the commencement of his term of office as President, by September 30 the President-elect shall should make all of his appointments to State Committees and other Presidential appointments pertaining to his administration.

Among these appointments, the President-elect shall appoint a Nominating Committee consisting of:

- a. A chairman who shall be the then current President or; if unable to serve, the most recent Past President available, **and**
- b. One other Past President; and
- c. Three other members other than Past Presidents, who shall be past or present Regional Directors or Area Governors. (Revised 1/28/03 by the Excom) (Confirmed 4/15/03)
