President Benson called the Special Meeting of the State Board to order at 2:05 P, M. on December 29, 2020, and it was announced that the meeting was being conducted using Zoom, in compliance with California Executive Order N-33-20 and the recent California Department of Public Health Directive of October 9, 2020, and after the Pledge of Allegiance announced the attendees of Officers and Directors constituted a quorum and welcomed all.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVIOUS MEETING

Secretary Williams announced that the minutes of October 30, 2020, had been circulated on Constant Contact, and asked for approval of the minutes as written, which was approved by unanimous voice vote.

REVOCATION AND OR SUSPENSON OF BRANCH 66 (SONOMA)

President Benson announced that the first item before the Board is the Revocation and or Suspension of Branch 66 (Sonoma) Charter, for failure to comply with the minimum Branch requirements.

Secretary Williams announced that on December 10, 2020, the State Executive Committee recommended to State President Benson, the revocation of Branch 66 (Sonoma) Charter, based upon Regional Director 3, Dennis Pangburns concerns of December 7, 2020.

Secretary Williams announced that he notified in writing (1st class mail) and Email the Branch 66 leadership, John Long, Joseph Runnion and Marion Colony, of the reason for the action being taken against the Branch, the Branches right to be heard, either through appearance of a representative or by a letter to be received five days before the hearing on December 29, 2020, at 2:00 P.M.

Secretary Williams announced that he spoke with Branch 66 Treasurer Marion Colony, who indicated he was willing to voluntarily surrender the Branch 66 Charter, however he wanted to confirm with Joe Runnion his willingness to voluntarily close the Branch.

In attendance, Branch 66 leader, Joe Runnion, indicated that his membership had basically closed its operations because of the age of his members, lack of a quality meeting place, and his active members were interested in golf only.

Secretary Williams, moved that the Charter for Branch 66 Revocation, BE REVOKED but held in abeyance, pending voluntary submission of their Charter within ten days (January 8, 2021), allowing the records to reflect that Branch 66 voluntarily surrendered its Charter, with the motion seconded by Regional Director Pangburn, the motion was approved by the majority of the Board.

Williams announced that with the tentative settlement, hopefully our Insurance Carrier would consider this favorably in our upcoming Insurance renewal in May 2021.

FIRST QUARTER STATE ASSESSMENT.

Secretary Williams, on behalf of the 2020-21 Budget Committee, announces that the committee has recommended forgoing the first quarter assessment, normally due and payable January 15, 2021.

Treasurer Roy Hodgkinson advised the Board that the organization ended the year with a positive equity balance and forgoing the first quarter assessments would not impact the 2021 financial stability.

President Benson announced that upon approval of the 2021 Budget, the forbearance of the first quarter assessment could be approved concurrently.

2021 STATE BUDGET APPROVAL

2021 State President Williams, on behalf of the 2020-21 Budget Committee, announced that on December 11, 2020, Treasurer Roy circulated the proposed budget, with the Budget Overview indicating approximately \$18,500 under budget in 2020, with an additional \$6,000 from custodial accounts from closed Branches. 2021 State President Williams moved for approval of the 2021 Budget (Exhibit A), and the forbearance of the first quarter assessment of 2021, by the 2021 State Board, with State Vice President Kindle seconding the motion, which was passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the Board, President Benson adjourned the meeting of December 29, 2020, at 2:57 P.M.
