



2020 Assessment Recommendation

- Assessments have not been raised since 2015
- We are losing Branches and continue to lose ~3% to 4% of our net membership annually
- Regions are spending more by having more AGs meet with their BS/LS, and Region training is more expensive
- More Officers and Chairmen are attending State meetings
- The plan is to hold at least three and possibly six Town Hall Meetings in 2020
- The subject was broached at the Annual Meeting and provided no objection
- Recommendation: Raise the 2020 assessment by \$1/member/year – payable quarterly

2020 Board, Annual and Town Hall Meetings

- Board Meetings January, March, May, August, October
 - Likely will be held at Paradise Valley in Fairfield (Saturdays?)
 - Booking at Rossmoor is becoming a problem
 - Location is more central, rental and lunch is inexpensive
- Annual Meeting Late August
 - Likely will be held at Chardonnay GC in Napa
 - Nice facility, central location, cost of rental, AV and lunch within last year's budget
 - Likely will hold a 9 hole tournament and bring in wineries for tasting after meeting
- Town Hall Meetings One set in February, possibly one in October/November
 - Looking at holding one in San Jose, Fairfield, Sacramento

Use of Constant Contact

- Constant Contact is a leading email service with over 650K customers
 - It allows the user to create email newsletters, surveys, events, Facebook promotions among other uses
- Currently used at the State level for all emails since 2019
 - Easily tailored to discrete groups of recipients
 - Attachments are easily added
 - Easily determine who has not opened the email, clicked through and unsubscribed
 - Program can automatically send a reminder

Use of Constant Contact (cont'd)

- We are recommending its *optional* use it at the Branch level
 - Positive reasons for implementing it
 - Can send one email or 10,000 eliminates batch sending
 - Easy to use Zero technical skill and great customer service
 - Excellent membership data base can include many fields like wife, address, nick name, etc.
 - Easy to set up message groups Newsletter, officers, activities, etc.
 - Can track who opens it, clicks through, measures responses
 - Identifies unsubscribes
 - Sends automated reminders to those not opening
 - Can be the backbone or an email marketing program
 - Potential negative consequences
 - Modest expense \$12/month
 - New way of doing things

Decision – will its usage benefit the Branches?

Use of Constant Contact (cont'd)

- Suggested implementation steps
 - Assign roll out to G&M (Tony deLosada) and tech support to InfoSys (Rick Sale)
 - Primary targets are the larger Branches
 - President to announce program and benefits to Branches (BS, LS, Secretary, MemSec)
 - Initial email, AG training, February Town Halls
 - G&M collects sign ups and answers questions
 - InfoSys (Rick) prepares a short email how to implement
 - Each Branch gets a Constant Contact rep from InfoSys

Collection of Branch Membership Lists

- Difference between Rosters and Membership Lists
 - State Rosters and the State Roster Chairman
 - Area Rosters and the Area Governor
 - Branch Rosters and the Membership Chairman
 - Outside parties sponsoring Branch Rosters
- NEW Branch Membership Lists and the Branch Membership Chairman
 - Forms 65, "Branch Membership List" and 65A, instructions
 - Due by each March 1
 - Responsibility of the Branch Secretary
 - Prepare during November/December to have it ready for deadline
